
Put the motorcycle on the centre stand and put a support under the rear wheel.

2

Remove the screw connecting the triangle link and pull rods.

3

Remove the lower shock absorber screw.



MOUNTING INSTRUCTIONS

4

Loosen the voltage regulator and move it out of the way.

5

Remove the upper shock absorber screw. Raise the swing arm and remove the shock absorber downwards.

6

Mount the Öhlins shock absorber in reverse order.

Note!


Lower the vehicle so that the suspension is slightly compressed before you tighten the screws.

7

Mount the hydraulic pre load master cylinder between the frame and the right passenger foot rest. Use original screws and put the supplied washers (21617-15) between the Öhlins bracket and the foot rest.

Caution!

Make sure that you tighten all screws to the correct torque and that nothing fouls or restricts movement of the shock absorber/front fork/ steering damper when the suspension is fully compressed or extended.
